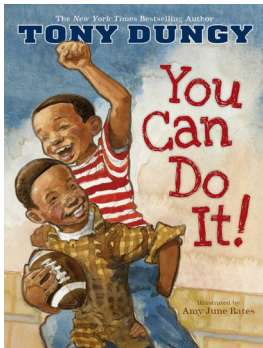

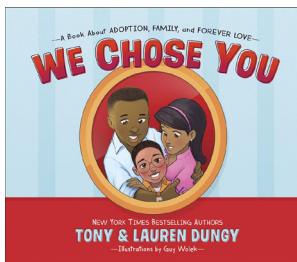


Team Dungy Book Series
